Features include a large tempered glass windshield with walkthrough, wide pathways from bow to stern and plenty of large storage compartments to hold dive tanks, a portable cooler and fishing rods. Instrumentation and controls at the helm are ergonomically engineered and an optional Garmin electronics suite makes the DC 365 a joy to operate.

The cabin is easily accessible with a single piece fiberglass door and features solid wood accents with modern finishes, a forward berth and a comfortable aft berth.
